Resiliency During Crisis: Small Goals for Big Gains

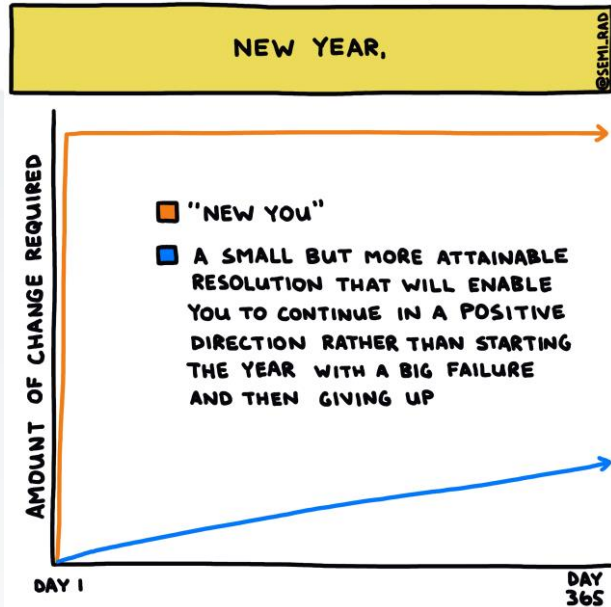
“If I cannot do great things, I can do small things in a great way.”
